



#### VISIT TO SIRPUR LAKE AS A BIRD WATCHING EXCURSION

Class XI students visited Sirpur Lake to watch the migratory birds. 99 Students assembled in the school at 6:30 am and started for Sirpur lake in the school bus with 8 faculty members.

The Guide cum Nature Volunteer at Sirpur Lake helped the students to spot many birds and also informed that on February 2, 2024, the Interpretation centre at Sirpur Lake will be inaugurated . The Sirpur wetland in Indore was declared as a Ramsar Site in August 2022. Among the well-known species of the birds spotted were the Ruddy Shelduck, Rosy Pelican, Blue Kingfisher, Asian green bee-eater and the Indian Robin.

In the celebration of freedom's light.





Taking the MUB Activity a step ahead, today the students of class V were taken on a Virtual Tour Of Foods Of India.


Another lovely dimension of our rich culture was introduced to them as the different cuisines of our country. They dived into the world of fragrant spices and exotic ingredients.


