

The 99th Birthday of our Divine Master, Sri Sathya Sai Baba was celebrated with fervent devotion.


The programme began with the mellifluous devotional songs by the school choir. The audience was awestruck by the impressive band performance by the school band.


### Capacity Building Program













# SPINNING WORKOUT FOR GARDIOVASCULAR ENDURANCE (CLASS VII)


















#### BEAUTY LIES IN THE EYES OF THE BEHOLDER


